Fall 2023 Enrollment

Fall Census: October 7, 2023

> Overall Registrations: 25,568 Total Headcount

- Positive increases in total residential full-time student enrollments (1.6% over Fall 2022)
- Undergraduate retention rates have returned to pre-pandemic levels (91.9%)
- Undergraduate six-year graduation rate hits institutional record (85%)
- New international and full-time graduate student enrollments up again (larger that Fall 2021 & 2022)
- Fewer part-time domestic and Chinese graduate students expected

> Undergraduate Enrollment: 10,848 (Residential Undergraduate Enrollment: 10,099)

- New UG student class slightly ahead of 2,800 goal: 2,539 FY students, 274 transfers
- Class profile remains strong and diverse
- Non-traditional undergraduate registrations remain below pre-pandemic levels

Graduate and Professional Enrollment: 14,088

- Full-time, international, and professional registrations on track
- Part-time working-adult and Chinese student enrollments continue to lag behind pre-pandemic levels
- Returning graduate student totals were impacted by the graduation of the larger Pandemic surge enrollments and smaller new graduate student intakes in 2022
- Part-time working-adult and Chinese student enrollments continue to lag behind pre-pandemic levels








First Year Class Retention Rate: 2014-2022 Cohorts



First Year Retention Rate: Summer Academy Students and Total New First-Year Cohort








New Graduate and Professional Degree Students Fall 2021, 2022, 2023






