






## Dining


- West Hall renovated dining hall







## **Deep Dive – Lerner Health and Wellness**

- 2022
  - HVAC upgrades including air handlers, chiller, cooling tower, hot water boilers, water pumps, and digital HVAC building automation system
- 2023
  - Lobby wall refinishing/painting
  - Conversion of lower level racquetball courts to Olympic level weight training facilities
- 2024
  - New entry turnstiles
  - Remaining wall refinishing/painting; new weight room flooring; new furnishings for seating areas; new signage
  - New lobby reception desk



## **Southland Energy Conservation Project**




- Kicked off in January 2024.
